

## What do the PR numbers mean at VW, Audi, Seat and Skoda?

The identification of brake parts is no longer possible using only the vehicle, period of construction and/or chassis number. Since 1999 a clear definition of brake parts can be obtained from the so-called PR numbers. These are always **triple-digit codes** and are called for example "1KD" or "1LB". These codes can be found on the customer service data sticker in the trunk and in the service handbook.
